Citizen Owned Companies will be given preference. The bidder should have the capability and capacity to provide slope support services

Brief

The purpose of this scope of work is to provide slope support to Orapa Mine AK1 pit in the form of Cable Bolts, Wiremesh Draping, Gabion Retaining Walls, Shotcreting, Tie Back walls, Slope support performance monitoring instrumentation and In-pit Surface Water Management Infrastructure. The aim of this project is to enhance the slope stability at Orapa AK1 pit as a means of mitigating against slope failure risk.

The scope of work in this tender shall entail but not limited to the following:

- Cable Anchors Installation:
- Shotcreting
- Wire-mesh Draping
- Slope Support Performance and Stability Monitoring:
- In-pit Surface Water Management Infrastructure Construction and Installation
